Official Artist **Daniel dos Santos** was the 2007 Jack Gaughan Award winner, and has also won both a Chesley Award and a Silver Medal Award from Spectrum. His work spans a variety of genres, and his clients include Disney, Tor Books, and Wizards of the Coast.

Special Guest **Toni Weiskopf** became the head of Baen Books after Jim Baen's death in 2006. Before that, she edited numerous books and anthologies, and co-wrote *Greasy Grimy Gopher Guts* (1995) with Joseph Sherman.

Featured Filker **Tricky Pixie** is a fusion of S. J. Tucker, Betsy Tinney, and Ben Deschamps. They use a wealth of instruments, including all manner of strings, voices, and drums, to entertain and delight.

NESFA Press Guest **Jerry Pournelle** is well-known for his classic Science Fiction writing with strong military themes, and his curmudgeonly computer reviews in *Byte* magazine. He is best known for his collaborations with Larry Niven, including *The Mote in God's Eye*, and the Prometheus Award winner *Fallen Angels* (with Michael Flynn).
